**Subscriptions are due on 1st April for the year 2008-2009.**

Annual rates are as follows: £35 for senior athletes, £25 for second-claim, under 20 or students, £15 for under 17. For partnerships (eg. husband/wife) £45 and for additional family members £10 per person.

Far reaching changes have recently been made in our sport. Every competitive athlete over the age of eleven now needs to be individually registered with England Athletics. The registration fee is £5 per year. If you are not registered England Athletics tell us that you will not be allowed to take part in any track & field, cross country or race walking events, or any road race championships. You will be able to take part in open road races without registration but will have to pay an additional fee for each race.

The club has to collect this registration fee and pass it on to England Athletics.

If you are a senior (over 20) athlete and are and are due to pay the normal subscription fee of £35 and registration fee of £5 we are offering you the chance to pay by standing order – it's just £3.50 per month – and full details of how to do this are on the next page.

If you want to continue to pay in your normal way then you are free to do so but remember, if you do not pay the additional registration fee then England Athletics will not allow you to compete.

We are sure that you will agree that Belgrave Harriers offers a great deal to members in the way of training facilities, free entry to team championship and league events, and general support. This cost of doing this far outweighs your membership fee but for the club to continue to offer this support we really do need your subscriptions to be paid as soon as possible.

Our records show that your annual rate is £            but you must add another £5 if you want to be registered. Cheques should be made payable to Belgrave Harriers.

If you don't pay the normal subscription rate of £35 but want to take advantage of payment by standing orders – or would like to pay quarterly or six monthly – please feel free to adapt the details on the standing order form or contact the Membership Secretary who will advise you.



## Payment Options

1. To pay in the normal way, send your cheque or postal order to the Membership Secretary together with the payment notification.
2. To pay by standing order you can opt for:
  - o One annual payment – £35 for membership only, £40 to include registration.
  - o Twelve monthly payments – £3.00 for membership only, £3.50 to include registration.

If you have on-line access to your bank account you can set the payments up yourself – and then send the Membership Secretary an email or send him the completed payment notification to tell him what you have done. Make sure that you include your name as a reference, otherwise we won't know who the money has come from.

Or you can complete the enclosed Standing Order Mandate and return it to the Membership Secretary for him to send on to your bank.

When completing the Standing Order Mandate, use capital letters:

Section A Fill in the **name and address** of your bank, then your **bank sort code** and your **bank account number**.

Section B Write **your name** in the reference box.

Section C **Subscription fee** – either £35 (annual) or £3.00 (monthly).  
**Registration fee** – either £5 (annual) or £0.50 (monthly). If you don't intend to compete then do not enter anything in this box.  
**Total payment** – the sum of the above two amounts - £40 or £3.50.  
**Total payment in words**.  
**Timing of payment** – whatever suits you best, to fit in with the payment frequency you have chosen – examples: “5th day of every month ” (monthly), “1st day of April”.  
**Frequency** – Annually or monthly. Cross out the one that doesn't apply.  
**Start date** – The due date of your first payment – example: “1st April 2008.”  
**Total number of payments** – If you want to restrict your payments then cross out “Until further notice” and enter the number of payments you want to make. Example: if your frequency is monthly and you write “24” in this box then your payments will cease after two years and you'll have to complete another Standing Order Mandate at that time.

Section D **Sign and date** the form.

When returning your payment and payment notification or completed Standing Order Mandate, send it to:
