Whetstone, Leicester – 1967

The inaugural AAA National Road Relay Championship took the place of the National London to Brighton Relay, last held in 1965 over roads that had become far too busy to sustain a race of such stature. Sir William Carr of *The News of the World* presented the magnificent London to Brighton Relay Trophy to the AAA as a perpetual trophy for what became known as "The National 12-Stage". In the preview of the new event *Athletics Weekly* reported:

"... though many of us mourn the loss of one of the greatest events ever included in the athletic calendar, this ... will see a new phase in road relay running."

The race was staged at the English Electric Company works over a figure of eight circuit with a large lap of 5 miles 1600 yards and a small one of 3 miles 705 yards, each run alternately, giving a total distance of 55 miles 1,510 yards.

The venue for the second edition of the National 12-Stage Road Relay was the Leicester Sports Centre, felt by some to be an improvement on the previous year's circuit at the English Electric Company, with the start/finish and hand-overs all taking place on the athletic track. The long stage was 5 miles 1,492 yards and the short stage 2 miles 1,502 yards for a total distance of 52 miles 364 yards.

Sutton Park, Sutton Coldfield – 1970 to 1972

After three years in Leicester, the National 12-Stage Road Relay moved to Sutton Park, Sutton Coldfield, where the long stage was 5.6 miles and the short one 3.1 miles – total distance 52.2 miles. The laps started on the diagonal road at the top of the car park and then headed south west until they joined the top road. A very sharp right turn at the top of the hill was then taken to go on to the course as used from 1974. Near the end of the lap, on the way back up the hill from Town Gate, halfway up the rise, a left turn was made to go onto the diagonal road to the finish.

Sutton Park, Sutton Coldfield – 1974 to 2010

The race returned to Sutton Coldfield in 1974 with a course that we are told has remained unchanged to this day. Originally the laps were described as 5.4 miles and 3 miles, giving a total distance 50.4 miles. The long stage is now described as 5.38 miles and the short stage as 2.995 miles, giving a total distance of 50.25 miles.

At each takeover, incoming and outgoing runners originally touched hands but at some stage (after 1984) the finish line and start line were separated by 10 metres and an official indicated to the outgoing runner when he should set off. This had the effect of reducing the total distance by 120 metres, which makes the early team times even more remarkable.

However, in view of the fact that the long stage times set in the '70s and '80s remain pre-eminent, and the total elapsed times of the '80s are now never neared, one has to wonder whether the turn at the end of the long stage at Streetly Gate was permanently marked and perhaps varied from year to year (as did the turn on the six stage relay until 2001). The old stagers refute this and point to a fall in long distance running standards – but that might not account for the whole story. More investigation remains to be done.
